## Salaries for Local Government Employees: How Does NYC Measure Up?

Since 2004, the average salary gap between municipal employees in New York City and those in the four largest California cities, which have the highest average government worker salaries, increased. Meanwhile, the gap between New York City and other large cities in Texas and around the country narrowed.
